The electronic courtroom is a trial presentation system installed with cutting-edge, easy-to-use technology for civil and criminal trials.

The heart of the system is a high-speed network that links television monitors and peripheral devices.

The nerve center is the "Power Podium" which replaces the traditional lectern with a high-tech electronic presentation platform that is networked to large monitors located in front of the jury and smaller monitors for each counsel table, the witness and the court reporter.

The system is controlled from the Judge's bench by a touch screen monitor.
