



HOME Investment Partnerships Program **ANNOUNCEMENT**

Are you a Hinds County resident who needs financial assistance with a few household repairs?

Hinds County is offering residents an opportunity to apply for funds through the HOME Investment Partnerships Program to assist existing homeowners with repairs, rehabilitations or reconstruction of owner-occupied units. The elderly, disabled and veterans are encouraged to apply.

Who is eligible to apply for funding?

1. Must be a rural Hinds County resident;
2. Residence must be located in rural Hinds County;
3. Residence must have been constructed from 1978 to present;
4. Applicant must be Low to Moderate Income. (80% or below of Median Family Income);
5. Applicant must own the structure that they want to have rehabilitated;
6. Applicant must reside in the dwelling as their principal place of residence and must have lived in the home for one (1) year prior to completing application.

What's the deadline to apply?

Residents have until September 22, 2011 to get their completed applications submitted.
